Endoscopy Unit

Whitfield & Brown have recently undertaken 3 phases of work at Arrowe Park Hospital refurbishing the Endoscopy Unit.

Works involved the complete refurbishment of the Endoscopy Ward including major M&E services replacement. Throughout the works we had to isolate the services from the adjacent ward to enable our works to proceedwith minimum disruption to the patients and existing hospital users.

The works were located on the 3rd floor of the main block at Arrowe Park Hospital adjacent alive ward. All our site staff had to use existing passenger lifts to access the works. We employed a banksman to ensure the staff, patients and visitors were protected whilst workmen and materials pass through the public areas. The 2m hoarding surrounding the site had to be locked at night with secure window protection.

M&E ran through the Endoscopy ward fromadjacent wards. We had to isolate the M&E to ensure we could shut down the services to our works without any effect on the existing wards.


