Ashley High School, Widnes

New 6th Form Block

Ashley High School has enhanced its facilities with a standalone single storey extension that provides a new 6th form block suitable for pupils and young adults up to the age of 19.

The school specialises in teaching young people with social communication needs and high functioning autism and improves its provision for vocational learning within the new structure by introducing, Hairdressing and a cyber café. In addition to this, the main activity room has individual stations where pupils can learn trades such as brickwork, plumbing, decorating and plastering. Other ancillary areas include staffroom, offices and kitchen, toilet facilities.

The new building situated at the rear of the school is 300m² overall and constructed from portal steel frame insulated with brick/block cavity external walls & ventilated ground bearing insitu concrete floor slab concrete pad and strip foundation footings and steel deck roof.
