Whitfield & Brown were delighted to be appointed by The Christie to re-configure an existing ward thereby improving bed space and the total patient experience at their hospital in Withington.

The improvements have created a bright, modern space and with the use of butterfly and wild flower wall graphics throughout both the reception and ward areas, we have created a contemporary identity and a more peaceful environment in which patients can recover.

The ward is located on the first floor with access via a fire escape and through trust offices. The ward was completely stripped back to internal block and involved extensive M&E works.

The new ward now consists of six bed bays and one side room along with nurse station, staff office, patient day room and other ancillary areas.
