Alder Hey Children's NHS Foundation Trust Rehabilitation & Physiotherapy Unit

Whitfield and Brown have completed the refurbishment of the existing Physiotherapy ward at Alder Hey Children's NHS Foundation Trust.

The project has been supported by The AF Foundation, a children's charity set up by Andrew and Rachael Flintoff that raises funds to build, develop and improve Child Rehabilitation & Physiotherapy Units throughout the UK.

The existing ward has been modernised throughout with glazed floor to ceiling partitions to retain privacy and minimise noise whilst creating an open environment and optimise day light.

The refurbishment has created 6 bed relaxation bays and treatment rooms, a quiet room, 2 physiotherapy areas that include gymnasiums complete with soft mat area, treadmill, parallel bars, youth bike, cross trainer, rowing machine, basket ball hoop, goal post, a new reception and waiting area.

The work completed in two phases also incorporated the extension to staff offices complete with IT work stations and staff meeting area.

All apparatus for the ward has being donated and a mural has been painted on the walls to make the space welcoming to the children.
