Construction of New Changing pavilion

The project comprised the construction of a new single storey changing pavilion for the use of the local community in the Kensington Regeneration Zone.

Liverpool City Council worked in partnership with Community 7 - part of the Riverside Group, Football Foundation, Liverpool Neighbourhood Regeneration Programme, Active City, Kensington Regeneration and Sport England to develop and fund the project.

As well as being a striking design, the unique structure contains 8 secure changing rooms, storage and a community meeting room with kitchen facilities.
