# Chaplaincy



Whitfield and Brown have undertaken major refurbishment works to create a new chaplaincy for Carmel College.

#### The works were carried out in two phases:

#### Phase 1

Conversion, including structural alteration works to existing Lecture Theatre to Chapel/Chaplaincy.

#### Phase 2

Conversion including structural alteration works to part of existing administration block to form new offices, WC accommodation and boiler plant room.

Students at the college were invited to design the three feature stain glass windows. The central panel symbolises the Holy Spirit and, the side panels represent the region of Mount Carmel. The students agreed that the experience has been useful for their chosen careers.

#### Other works included:

- Licensed asbestos removal to all areas of the works
- Demolition of C Block
- New drainage runs/connections, diversion of mains incoming electrical and gas services, new internal services distribution, fire alarm, intruder alarm and IT installation
