Medical Records Department Refurbishment

The contract to modernise existing accommodation comprised of a complete strip out and refurbishment to floors, ceilings, lightning, partitioning and general decorative finishes in 3 phases over a14 week duration.

The refurbishment has created a departmental booking in/goods inward for patient records received from off site facilities complete with work stations for 10 hospital employees, a large open plan office with work stations sufficient for 60 staff, training room, kitchen and rest rooms.


The medical records department access is located on the first floor with access being next the main circulation area and social zone/shops

Key Aspects

- ✓ Materials are evacuated via rubbish chutes, over the hospital roof in to sealed containers.
- ✓ Material deliveries are received at the main loading bay and then transferred to the department via scaffold staircase to minimise patient interaction.
