Macmillan Cancer Support, Delamere Centre Halton General Hospital

Whitfield & Brown has constructed a new Resource Centre and information point for Macmillan Cancer Support Services at Warrington Hospital

The contract comprised of the creation of a reception area containing information facilities and desk; lounge/waiting areas; two complimentary therapies rooms, quiet room, storage areas, meeting area and a window seat.

Architects ADP have designed the area to provide a welcoming and relaxing atmosphere using natural daylight through the roof lights and the effective use of artwork.

The building is generally of a white render finish and the therapy rooms are clad in timber. Outside, sensory planting and seating areas to create meditative / contemplative areas are included in the landscaping.
