Construction of teaching block & leisure

Whitfield & Brown worked with architects LAWRAY and Cheshire County Council to create a new multi-purpose learning space and leisure facilities for 11 to 16 year olds at Malbank High School in Nantwich, Cheshire.

This project involved the construction of a new two storey teaching block which contains 17 classrooms, seminar and tutorial rooms and a fully equipped information and technology centre.

There are two fully equipped science laboratories with preparation rooms, an Information Technology room, with all the necessary computer trunking and other services.

An impressive feature of the building is a central glazed dome, with heat and rain sensors, giving a light and spacious feel to the top floor.

As the building was constructed on the schools former tennis courts, we also created four new hard courts to the rear of the building.
