



Reaseheath College Animal Management Facilities



This design and build project comprises the demolition of eight existing buildings and the new build of a single storey steel frame building to house mammals, insects, aquatics, reptiles and amphibians as well as teaching rooms, administration and ancillary areas.

The single storey, steel frame, BREEAM rated building has a construction value just short of £2million and provides impressive accommodation for students seeking a qualification in animal care and welfare.

Rease Health is the first college in the country to be granted a zoo licence and the new facility comprises of reception, administration areas, meeting/teaching rooms complete with specialist units that house over 1000 animals and around 200 species of mammals, birds, amphibians, reptiles, invertebrates and fish.
