Southport College Refectory Extension

Whitfield and Brown increased the student dining facility by extending the refectory. The refectory was constructed within a court yard that sits at the centre of the campus.

Access to the site was restricted by a narrow road that decreased in to a 2m walk way for access for men, materials and machinery.

The modern facility has split level dining and was constructed by way of steel frame and feature relief stack bonded black brickwork both inside and out with glazed curtain walling. To address the colleges sustainability agenda the building was designed to accommodate a green sedum roof and mono-draft natural ventilation system.
